# TIEBREAK RULES (LEAGUE STANDINGS) 

If teams are tied after the 10th or 11th league games, the order of finish will be determined as follow:

## If $\mathbf{2}$ teams are tied

1.Most wins during league play
2. Best record between the 2 tied teams during league play.
3. The team with the best goals average gains the higher position.

The goals average is to be determined in the following manner:
Take \# of goals for divided by the total \# of goals for and against
NOTE: All games included
EXAMPLE: Goals For: 10 Goals Against: 4
10
$10+4=.714$
4. Best Plus / Minus during all league games.
5. Goals for during all league games.
6. Goals against during all league games.
7. Coin flip

## If $\mathbf{3}$ teams or more that are tied

1. Most wins during all league games.
2. The team with the best goals average gains the higher position
( see formula above)
3. Best Plus / Minus during all league games.
4. Goals for during all league games.
5. Goals against during all league games.
6. Coin Flip

At no time will teams using the above $3+$ team tiebreaker formula go back to the two-team tiebreaker. If teams are tied for most wins in step 1 final placement will be determined by goals against formula.

NOTE: A maximum difference of 7 goals per game to the final score (goals for and against) would apply in the determination of any tie-breakers and the finishing positions for both teams

# TIEBREAK RULES (TOURNAMENT ONLY) 

## If 2 teams are tied

1. Winner of the game between the two teams
2. Most wins in round robin play
3. The team with the best goals average gains the higher position.

The goals average is to be determined in the following manner:
Take \# of goals for divided by the total \# of goals for and against
NOTE: All games included
EXAMPLE: Goals For: 10 Goals Against: 4
10
$10+4=.714$
4. Best Plus / Minus during all games in round robin play (goals for minus goals against)
5. Goals for during all games in round robin play
6. Goals against during all games in round robin play
7. Least amount of penalty minutes
8. Coin flip

## If 3 or more teams are tied

1. Team that has best record versus the other tied teams. NOTE: All tied teams must have played against each other in round robin or this criteria will not be applicable.
2. Most wins in round robin play

3 The team with the best goals average gains the higher position. (See formula above)
4 Best plus / minus during all games in round robin play. (goals for minus goals against)
5 Goals for during all games in round robin play.
6 Goals against during all games in round robin play.
7 Least amount of penalty minutes
8 Coin flip
At no time will teams using the above $3+$ team tiebreaker formula go back to the two-team tiebreaker. If teams are tied for most wins in step 2 final placement will be determined by goals against formula.

NOTE: A maximum difference of 7 goals per game to the final score (goals for and against) would apply in the determination of any tie-breakers and the finishing positions for both teams
